NINE MILLION SPENT IN YEAR

Expenditures of \$9,098,681.45 were made by the Portland office of the O-W. R. & N. during 1921, according to a statement of the year's work just compiled by the accounting department. These expenditures included the payroll of the O-W. and the San Francisco & Portland Steamship company, the taxes of the O-W., the Portland Terminal Investment company, and the Riverside Homestead company, and the purchases of the railroad, the steamship company and the dining car and hotel department.

The payroll of 2603 employees and the steamship company amounted to \$1,851,469.56, the taxes amounted to \$274,034.02, and the purchases \$3,883,177.15.

Muskellunge Gamest of Fish.

Well named the Tiger of the Fresh Water, the muskellunge is today the most sought after big game-fish of the country.
