## AT SHERRY'S TODAY.

A Chinese wedding, carried out just as it is in China, with Sessue Hayakawa as the groom and Truru Oaki, who, in real life, is Mrs. Hayakawa, as the bride, is one of the many colorful and interesting incidents in "Five Days to Live," Mr. Hayakawa's current R-C production, now being screened at the Sherry Theatre.

In China a wedding ceremony is ordinarily of a week's duration, and while it was, of course, impossible to consume so much time on the screen, nothing of the pomp and glory of the ceremony, down to the smallest detail was omitted in acting it for "Five Days to Live."

Teuru Aoki, as the bride, is seen wearing the conventional wedding costume, which is of almost barbaric splendor. It consists of an overcoat and trousers of heavy purple silk, and an over-jacket of silk in many colors and shades, including blues, green, yellow, reds, richly embroidered in flower and butterfly designs.

The most significant part of the costume, however, are the tiny silver bells which are hung about on panels covering the trousers, and which give forth a faint tinkle as the bride moves about. It is said that

each of these bells expresses a wish for a male heir, and their absence from the wedding costume would be a mark of great impiety by the bride.

Sessue Hayakawa, as the groom, wears a rich garment of crimson silk, heavily embroidered with gold and silver thread. He, too, wears an ornate head dress.

The Buddhist priest who performs the ceremony is a curious figure with his close-cropped hair and long flowing robe, which is thrown over one shoulder and caught under the arm on the opposite side. He carries with him a long ebony stick, topped off by a tuft of hair, which he sways to and fro before him as he kneels and asks the blessings of Buddha for the newly-wed couple.

An unusually elaborate setting was designed and built at the studio for this ceremony and thousands of dollars were spent to secure the rare Oriental furnishings and statues, rug and tapestries used in the temple.

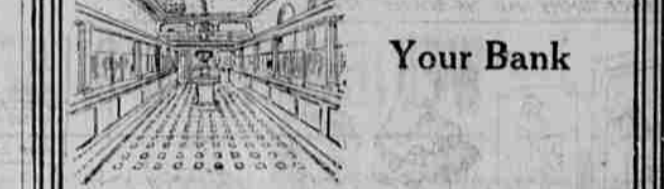

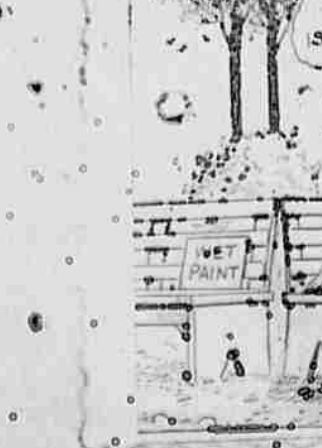
