

BAKER PIONEER DIED MONDAY

Edgar E. Chambers Came to Oregon in Year 1862; Built Railroads Early in Life.

BAKER, May 11.—The death of Edgar E. Chambers, aged 72, a pioneer resident of Baker county, occurred Monday evening at 6 o'clock, following a long illness with heart trouble. The deceased came to Baker county with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. William Chambers, in 1862, and this place has been his home since. With his father, before the building of the railroad, he engaged in freighting with teams, hauling freight from Umatilla on the Columbia river to Boise, Idaho, later engaged in farming and recent years followed concrete work when his health would permit. He was born in Indiana in 1850. Mr. Chambers is survived by his widow and eight children: Mrs. Alice Johnson, San Francisco; Mrs. A. H. Phillips, Los Angeles; Mrs. C. D. Williams, Pasadena; Charles Chambers, Wenatchee, Washington; Marie Chambers and Edgar and Frank Chambers of Baker; two sisters, Mrs. James Cavin, Baker; and Mrs. Frank Pny, La Grande.

ANCIENT CUSTOM WAS OBSERVED

(By Associated Press) LONDON, May 11.—Westminster Abbey was the scene today of one of those quaint medieval customs of which many still survive in some form in London. This was the annual distribution of the King's "Mundy money" by the Lord High Almoner, the Dean of Wells.

Custom dictates that the number of recipients of this bounty shall be twice the King's age and 25. King George is now 57 years old. There were 57 old men and a similar number of old women seated in the choir stalls to receive the money, surrounded by a number of Yeomen of the Guard in their black and red costumes.

At the beginning of the service, a procession was formed in the nave. Nosegays were carried in medieval days to counteract unwholesome miasms from the lack of sanitation and to keep off the plague. Flowers were carried today but only to keep up old custom and not for the original purpose.

At the head of the procession came the Sergeant-Major of the Yeomen carrying a gold dish on which were 114 red and white kid purses containing the Mundy money which consisted of small silver coins, once current coin of the realm, but which now are minted specially for the occasion. The High Almoner and his assistants were dressed in white instead of the usual tovels which their predecessors used in Queen Elizabeth's time when they washed the feet of a number of old persons on Mundy, Tuesday.

WILLIAMS A JOKE AS VICE-CHAIRMAN

Fithian's opponent, Ralph E. Williams, has been sidetracked by the National Committee to a harmless vice-chairmanship and is useless to Oregon. WHAT IS WRONG WITH WILLIAMS?

Williams has no chance of becoming National Chairman and running the presidential campaign in 1924, or even the Western end of it.

The reason is that the National Committee seems extremely unwilling to trust Williams with the management of even the Pacific Coast part of the national campaign. For instance, in 1918, when a Regional Director for the Coast was selected, the Committee turned Williams down in favor of Raymond Benjamin of San Francisco. Then, in 1920, when Harding was running, Williams was again ignored and Elmer E. Dever of Tacoma was chosen to conduct the campaign on the Coast.

GOLF CONVERTS ARE INCREASING

(By Associated Press) SPOKANE, May 11.—Golf in Spokane this year boasts 25 per cent more converts than last year, with the immediate result that two of the three greens of the city are being standardized, and the third lengthened, at an aggregate cost of nearly \$20,000 for land and improvements.

Golfers of the Manito Golf Club have given up the nine-hole green leased by them for a number of years, and have bought a new green site at a cost of \$21,000. Work of building the links is already in progress. Play on the first nine will start probably sometime in July, and the second nine will be finished in time for the 1923 season.

Ground for an additional nine holes on the Downriver municipal links has been purchased by the park board for \$8,500. The second nine, completing the 18-hole standard course, will be finished by December 1, 1922. Local golfers contributed \$2,500 of the purchase price as a community gift, the board not being able to include the first payment on the land in this year's budget.
