

### When Airplanes Met Head-On



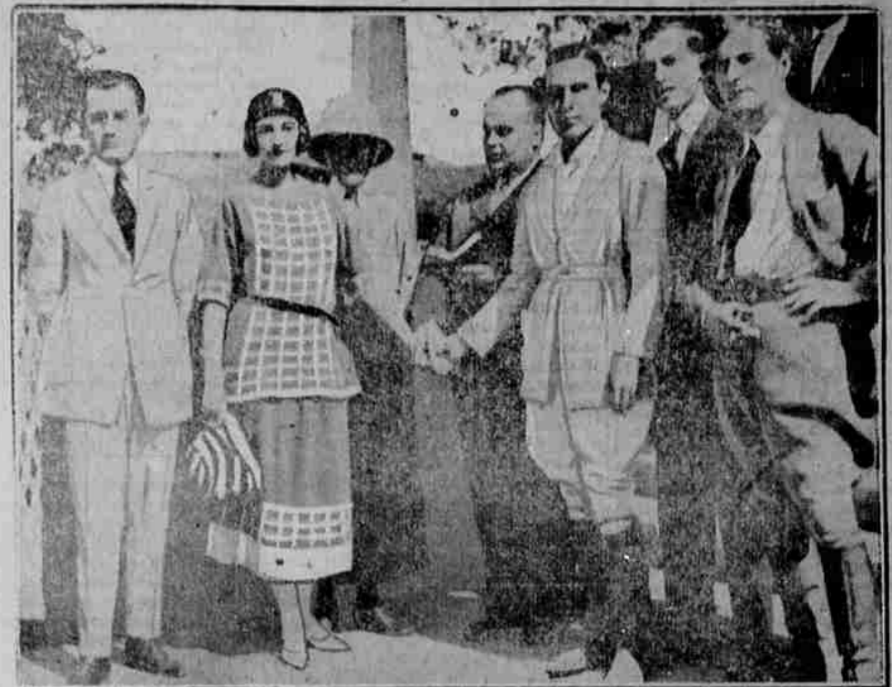
Wreck of the Paris-London airplanes which fell in a head-on collision above Thieuloy, France. Six persons were killed.

### And Then Rudolph's Troubles Started!



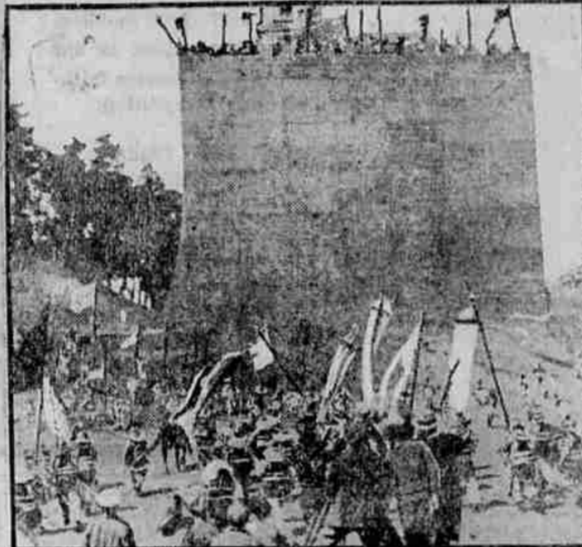

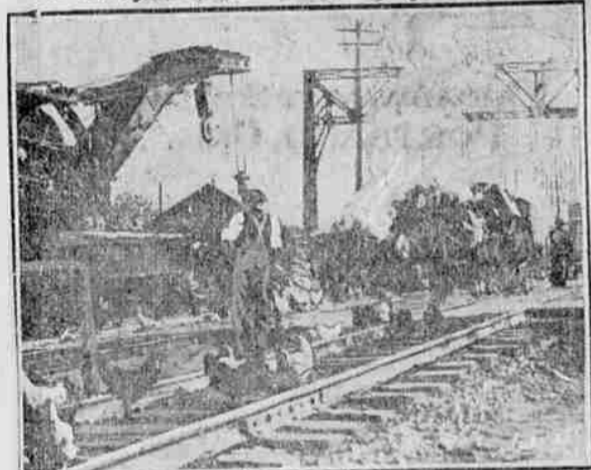
George Cook, Australian heavyweight boxer, and his bride, formerly Miss Emily Laura Hides, leaving the registry office at London after their marriage.

### Newlyweds



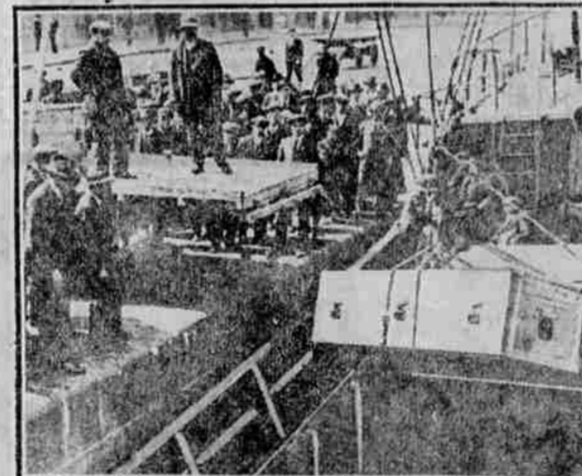

### Hero



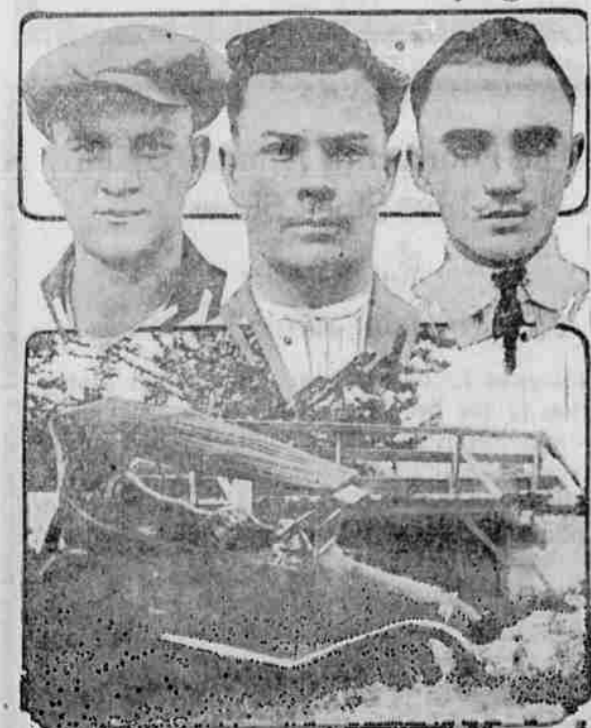

### Where Did You Get That Hat?



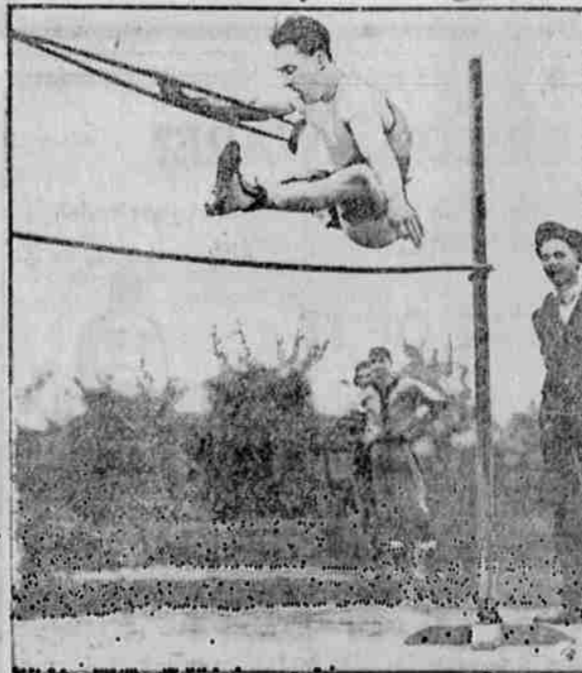

### Three on Trial for Slaying



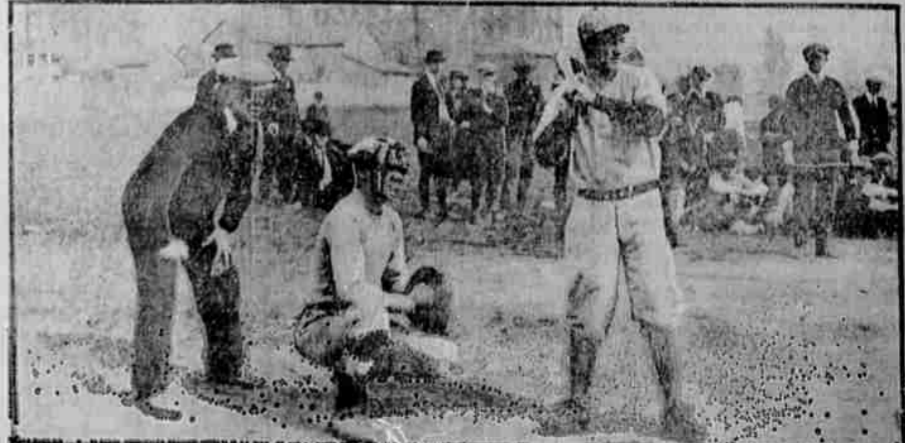
