farmers are not very careful. "I believe that anyone that is kind to animals and tries to use his best judgment when feeding them and a few other extras will and can make a success of it. We feed them twice a day excepting after the pups arrive, when we feed them three times. They don't require as much at times as chickens.

"Their fur or pelts are only taken from them during December and January and sell to dealers as from \$75 to \$100 each while sometimes one brings more. The higher prices are realized at private sales. The demand for pelts is very good and thousands of pelts are sold each year. The cross bred fox pelts bring from \$6 to \$75 each.

"When the pups come out of their dens the first day they play like kittens and fight like school boys. I don't believe there are many children who are as obedient as the little silver fox puppies. The old fox has a number of sounds that she makes—one to console the young, another to warn of danger, another, a sort of bark, when they want to try and scare an unwelcome visitor."
