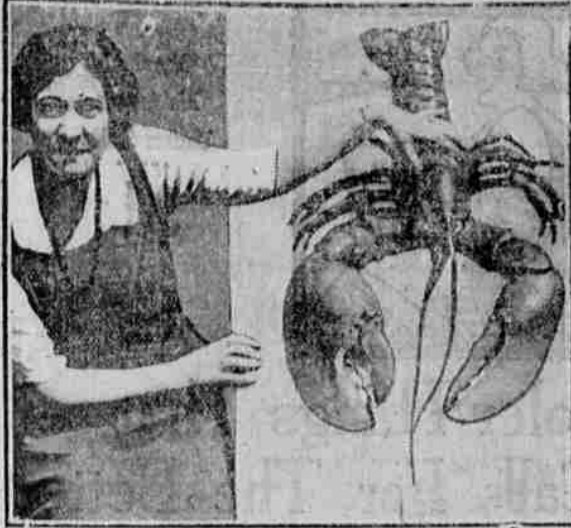


A Lady and a Lobster.

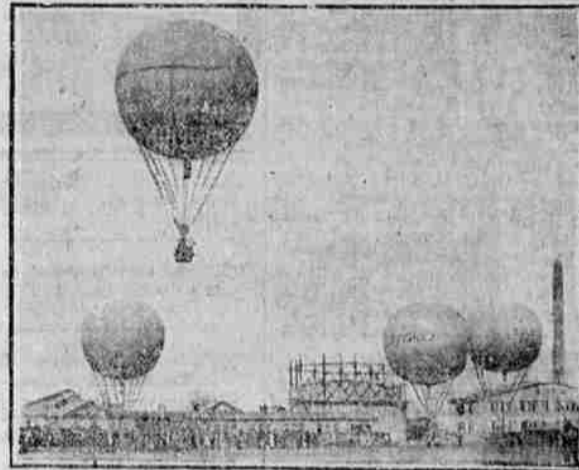
