

EUROPEAN BOYS WRITE LETTERS

European Boys Write Replies To Letters Written To Far Away Brothers Recently.

Some time ago, the local Boy Scouts decided to correspond with some of the boy scouts in different parts of the world. So a great many letters went from La Grande to European parts. A few days ago two answers were received, one from Czechoslovakia and one from Vienna, Austria.

The one from Czechoslovakia was received from F. Pukri, of Vesovic, Praha, Czechoslovakia, by Edward Fitzgerald and reads as follows: "I received your letter and I reply instantly. I am a Czechoslovakian boy scout. In our republic there are 18,000 scouts. There are boy scouts, old scouts and sea scouts. I am a sea scout. We ride in canoes, boats and houseboats.

"I send you a map of our republic and the postal stamps. We play some national games: Haseman, Podigenau, Hoppanan, Paaka, etc. Of English games it is a valley ball and football. I collect also coins. Do you know anything of our Republic? The Czechoslovakian republic lies right in the middle of Europe. It formerly belonged to the Austrian Empire, but since the 28th of October, 1918, it is an independent state. Our army fighting with American, English, French and Italian army. The Czechoslovak Republic consists of Bohemia, Moravia, the so-called countries of the Bohemian crown and of Slovakia and Carpathian Russia, which formerly were a part of Hungary. We have many beautiful mountains in the Republic. There are the Giant Mountains and the Sumara in Bohemia and the Tatra Mountains in Slovakia. The Republic is rich in fine rivers, several of which are navigable. The valleys are very fertile and produce wheat, barley, rye, oats and other cereals. In some places also wine and maize is grown."

The other letter was received by one of the other scouts, from Vienna, from Paul King, a boy of nineteen years. In speaking of sports he states, "I am a big friend of sports like fencing, swimming, lawn tennis, hockey and different other sports. But now I can't make any sport because it is so terrible dear everything. A tennis racket cost 21,000 Kronen, a hockey racket 18,000 Kronen and shoes are 30,000 to 45,000 Kronen (\$7 to \$10) and I earn in a whole month 12,500 Kronen and work 12 hours a day."

The latter letter indicates the remarkable low wages and high prices paid in the Austrian Empire.
