LITIGATION ON SCHOOL ENDED

ENTERPRISE, June 9.—As a reminder of the old county high school, and particularly of the litigation growing out of its abandonment, Judge J. W. Knowles has held that part of the site has reverted to Frank A. Reavis, the original owner. This consists of two acres, a quadrangular piece 193 by 203 feet, beginning 12 from the Enterprise hospital—the former high school building—and extending north the long way.

When the county high school was located at Enterprise it was placed on a tract of 11 acres on the hill at the east side of town. This came from four owners, three of whom gave deeds with clauses providing that their land should revert to them if the property ever were used for other than high school purposes.

After a few years the county voted to discontinue the high school. Two of the original owners gave deeds assigning to school district No. 21 their reversionary interests. Mr. Reavis did not give such a deed.

Under the reverted clause the district brought action to get possession of that part of the property originally given by A. M. Wagner. The supreme court held that the district had no right to bring such an action because Mr. Wagner had transferred nothing to the district. Then another action was instituted in Mr. Wagner's name, but the supreme court held he could not do so because he had transferred his rights. The district had no standing because it had received no rights from Mr. Wagner, and Mr. Wagner had no standing because he had transferred his rights. His rights had vanished into thin air.

This struggle called forth amusing criticism from eastern law authorities, but it stood as the equiv-

Arkansas River Frozen Over.

The weather bureau at Little Rock, Ark., advises that the Arkansas river at that point has several times been frozen to a depth that would allow teams to cross on the ice between Little Rock and North Little Rock, the municipality just across the river. From January 11 to January 27, 1918, the river was frozen, the ice on January 21 being five and one-half inches thick. From February 7 to February 17, 1923, the river was frozen over at Little Rock and teams crossed on the ice.
