PRICES RISING IN GERMANY

(By Associated Press)
BERLIN, June 21.—Prices on general merchandise in Germany have risen to such an extent that the foreigner no longer flocks into the country to do his buying. Shortly after the war prices were low, so low that the stores of Berlin were doing an enormous business with men and women from countries close to Germany, not to mention England and the United States, who found great advantages in buying here. Today Berlin prices are on a parity with the outside markets, according to an investigation made by a local paper, and the man on a business or pleasure trip to Germany now prefers to spend his spare money on amusements. The best German suitings and the best German underwear are as dear as in England, and British and Swedish enamel goods are cheaper than German. Hence, purchasing by outsiders during the past six weeks has been virtually eliminated.

TOURING U. S. IN TREE HOUSE

EVERETT, Wash., June 21.—That the people of the middle west may have an opportunity of seeing a section of a native Douglas fir, B. F. Blansett and son of Sultan, near here, have constructed a tree house with which they hope to tour

the United States. The house is hollowed out of a giant log. It is seven feet high with an exterior diameter of eight feet and an interior diameter of six feet. The roof of the house is made from twenty-three inch shakes, as is the front of the house. One of the shakes is used as a door. The house is mounted on a light truck.

Mr. Blansett plans to exhibit the tree house at intervals along the Sunset highway and the Oregon Trail, which roads he will follow to Omaha. He has not as yet arranged his itinerary from Omaha. He will carry with him letters of introduction from officials of the Everett chamber of commerce.

FOOD CONTROL RELINQUISHED

VIENNA, June 21.—With the termination of governmental control of the production of bread and breadstuffs, effective on the last day of April, the government has created a grain distributing corporation. This concern is to keep at all times 100,000 tons of cereals in stock. Of this 40 per cent is to be in mills or warehouses; 30 per cent in European ports and 30 per cent afloat between the United States and Europe. Any profits from these operations go to the federal treasury and, on the other hand, deficits are to be met by the government. The grain exchange reopened May 1.

REORGANIZING SCHOOL SYSTEM

(By Associated Press)
STOCKHOLM, June 21.—Sweden's educational system today faces reorganization. The purpose of which is to place full educational advantages within reach of every child in the land irrespective of the child's social standing in the community.

Under the new plan all of Sweden's public schools, from the elementary grades to the universities, will be co-educational. At present only the elementary schools and the universities receive both sexes. The Swedish school commission proposes to open the "realskola" and the "gymnasium" to girls as well as boys. An important change will be the elimination of several subjects as compulsory and the concentration of individual students on a smaller group of subjects, logically related to the occupation or profession which most interests them. Students will be permitted to start specializing much earlier than at present.

It is now proposed that virtually the whole educational work of the country, with the exception of a few private schools, be taken over by the state. Tuition fees will be

practically eliminated, and students will not be encumbered by the study of non-essential subjects. The estimated cost of the new system will be about \$1,000,000 a year more than at present.

It is proposed also to establish a school, new to the Swedish system of education, to be known as "lyceum" which in seven years will take a pupil directly from the elementary school to matriculation for the universities.

Among the languages offered under the new plan will be Latin and Greek and three modern languages in addition to Swedish, namely, English, French and German.
