ROAD TO BE OPEN EARLIER

(By Associated Press)
MISSOULA, Mont., June 28.—With the construction of the Lookout Pass road this season, the Yellowstone Trail highway through the St. Regis pass will be thrown open to traffic six weeks earlier than spring, according to Engineer Frank Andrews of the bureau of public roads. The contract for the work will be awarded this month so that work may start as soon as possible.

Each year the snow banks on the divide of the St. Regis Pass are a barrier to travelers during the spring months. The new road will be built with a southern exposure, securing a much earlier opening, according to Andrews. The state of Idaho has already built a road up to the state line but it cannot be used because Montana section of 2.50 miles is not yet constructed. The new stretch of highway follows the Northern Pacific railway closely from the state line to Sibley, where it connects with the present trail.

Contractors working on the west side of the Shalaho road out of Phillipsburg will have several hundred men working on that job by the last of this month, though it is only a short time since the snow left the upper Rock creek drainage.
