### AT SHERRYS TODAY

The magic spell of the long glistening beaches and awaying palms of the exotic South Seas was waiting into the Sherry Theatre last evening, when Jack Holt's new Paramount starring picture, "The Man Unconquerable," received its initial presentation.

It is a story of great power, dealing as it does with a young man who has been reared with a profound respect for law and order.
