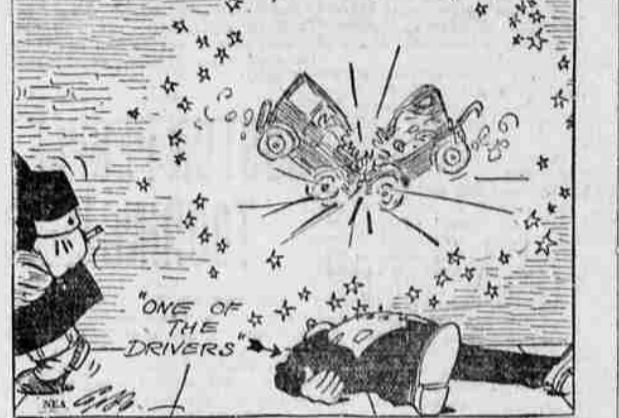

NEW QUARTERS FOR OLD BANK

LONDON, July 26; (By Mail)—The long projected rebuilding of the Bank of England will start immediately, the Daily Express understands. A meeting of the directors is to be held soon to make the necessary financial arrangements. It is understood that the plans to be adopted are those of Herbert Baker, the architect who collaborated with Sir Edwin Lutyens for the new capitol building at Delhi. Mr. Baker was also the designer of the South African government's administrative buildings at Pretoria, and of the cathedrals at Capetown, Pretoria and Salisbury (Rhodesia), and the Cecil Rhodes memorial on Table Mountain.

EMPEROR'S SON COMES OF AGE

TOKIO, Aug. 21.—Another branch of the Imperial family was established with the coming of age on June 25 of Prince Yoshita to Atarunomiya, second son of the emperor, who is a student at the military academy. He is now known as Prince Chichibu, the latter name being taken from a famous mountain northwestward of the Prince's palace in Tokio. With the giving of this name another precedent has been taken, the names of Imperial families having heretofore been chosen after names of localities in Kyoto, the ancient capital of Japan.
