

HUGE STEAMER CONTRACT LET

Contract for Building 600 Foot Bulk Freight Steamer is Let to American Ship Building Company; Delivery in 1923.

(By Associated Press.) CLEVELAND, O., Aug. 22.—Another contract for a 600-foot bulk freight steamer, for delivery in 1923, has just been placed with the American Ship Building Company here. The boat will be built at the Cleveland yards of the company and will be ready for delivery next May. The order was placed by the Interlake Steamship Company. The price was not announced. The new boat practically will be a duplicate of the two steamers ordered by the Pittsburgh Steamship Company (a subsidiary of the United States Steel Corporation) last May. The steamer will be 600 feet overall, 589 feet keel, 100 feet beam and 32 feet deep.

The Interlake Steamship Company operates the second largest fleet on the lakes and when the new boat comes out the company will have 52 vessels.

The American Ship Building company has booked orders for five freighters of the 600-foot type since last May, all for delivery in May, 1923. Four of the boats will be turned out at the Loraine, Ohio, yards. In addition to the freighters the company will build two passenger steamers for the Detroit & Cleveland Navigation company for 1924 delivery.

A six hundred foot steamer to come out late this season is now being built at the Ecorse yard of the Great Lakes Engineering works for the Wisconsin Transit Company. At the yard of the Toledo Ship Building company a steamer of the same class is being built for the Kinman Transit Company, of this city. A self-loading steamer building at the Manitowoc (Wis.) Ship Building company for Cleveland interests will be launched soon and will be placed in commission about the middle of next month.

ALABAMA GOLF MEET ATTRACTS

Seventh Annual Tournament of the Alabama Golf Association Finds Players From Virtually Every Club in Alabama.

(By Associated Press.) MONTGOMERY, Ala., Aug. 22.—Players representing virtually every club in Alabama have entered the seventh annual tournament of the Alabama Golf Association which starts over the course of the Montgomery Country club next Wednesday morning. Amateurs from several clubs outside the state are expected to participate in the tournament.

Play will continue through four days, closing with the finals and consolation next Saturday, August 26. A medal will be given to the player turning in the lowest qualifying score, and appropriate trophies will be awarded the winner and runner-up in the championship flight, and the winners of each of the lower sixteens.

The annual business meeting of the association will be held at the country club Wednesday evening. The following order of play has been announced by officials in charge of the tournament: Wednesday, August 23—Qualifying round, 18 holes of medal play. The 32 players returning the lowest scores will qualify in the championship division. The 32 returning the next lowest scores will form the second division and the third group of 32 will make up the third division.

From the championship division will be formed the championship and second flights of 16 players each, while the fifth and sixth flights will be composed of players

qualifying in the third division. Thursday, August 24—Morning Preliminary round, match play, championship division, 32 players at 18 holes. Second division, 32 players, at 18 holes; third division, 32 players at 18 holes. Afternoon—All flight will play first rounds.

Morning and afternoon rounds of 18 holes each will be played in all flights on Friday, and the final rounds on Saturday will go to 18 holes.

The Lane county fair will open at Eugene September 19 for a four-day period. Prospects are that the show will be the best ever held in the county.

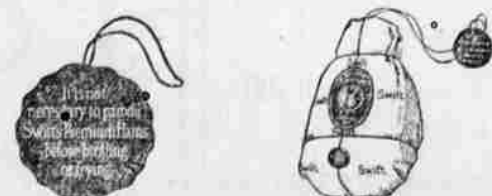
The wholesale price of ham is fifteen to twenty per cent lower than it was six weeks ago.
