REGISTRATION FOR ENGINEERS

CHICAGO, Sept. 15.—An arrangement between states which would permit an engineer registered in one state to practice in other states will be brought at a meeting of the Council of State Boards of Engineering Examiners to be held here October 2, according to C. S. Hammatt of Jacksonville, Fla., president of the council.

A tentative plan will be submitted at the meeting, he continued, "whereby the several state boards can make the state laws operative for reciprocal registration without changing them."

The states represented in the council comprise Arizona, Colorado, Florida, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Louisiana, Michigan, Minnesota, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Oregon, Pennsylvania, South Dakota, South Carolina, Tennessee, Virginia, West Virginia and Wyoming.

With the announcement of the meeting comes a statement from the offices here of the American Association of Engineers that the committee on the classification of engineering positions has issued its first report.

The committee, headed by A. R. McDaniel, educational specialist in the United States war department, is preparing an occupational index of engineering positions in the United States.
