UNSURVEYED LANDS FILED

NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the plat of the survey of the remaining unsurveyed lands in Twp. 7, S. R. 41, E. W. 34, viz: Sections 6, 7, 8, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 28, 29 and 32, of said Twp. 7, S. R. 41, E. W. 34, will be filed in this office on October 25, 1922, at 9 a. m., and that on and after said day the above lands will be subject to proper disposition.

The S. 1 SW 1 and S. 1 SE 1 Sec. 17, S. 1 Sec. 18, NE 1 NE 1 Sec. 19, E. 1 NW 1 NW 1, NE 1 SE 1 Sec. 20, and W. 1 Sec. 21, were withdrawn under the first form for the Baker Project. These lands will not be subject to

entry or disposal notwithstanding the filing of this plat until the lands are restored in accordance with law, except valid rights initiated under the public land laws prior to withdrawal or reservation and not defeated thereby.

Unless a contrary status is shown by the records of this office the other lands (Not in Baker Project) in said survey will be subject to entry or disposal in accordance with instructions of Circular 527 approved February 6, 1917, (45 L. D. 648), and Circular 822 approved May 1, 1922, superseding Circular 678 and 803 in the matter of filing plats and opening the lands for entry thereunder as per House Joint Resolution No. 30, approved January 21, 1922, extending the preference period granted ex-service men to ninety-one days before the restoration to the general public.
