MAY BE O'HARA MURDERER AGAIN

SPOKANE, Sept. 20.—August Bonjourn, nineteen, was shot and killed, and his brother, Joe, forty, was badly wounded at the Bonjourn ranch near Wilson creek, Grant county, last night by a stranger, whose description tallies with that of the man who attacked the O'Hara family near Olympia. The assailant attempted to carry off one of the Bonjourn girls, but was driven off by Mrs. Bonjourn. Joe is expected to survive.

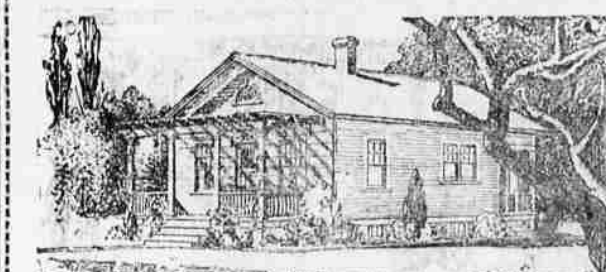
