JOHN EMERSON, ANITA LOOS. THEAT WORLD TO A SMILE

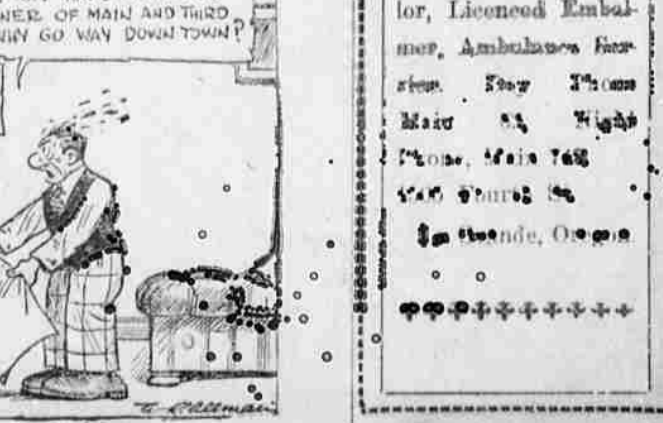
