# SWISHER BACKED BY HIS FRIENDS

Shooting at Baker Attracts Attention of Wallowa County People.

ENTERPRISE, Oct. 6.—At a preliminary hearing held on Monday, Justice A. B. Corvax's field Harry W. Swisher to the grand jury under bonds of \$5,000 for shooting and killing Vernon Baker, in Paradise, Tuesday morning, September 12. Three witnesses were heard, Dr. C. T. Hockley, Clarence L. South, county coroner, and Mrs. Oliver Boyer of La Grande, mother of Baker.

The hearing was largely perfunctory, to comply with the law, although Swisher's friends also wished it, so that his case would go at once to the grand jury and even to the circuit court. A full investigation, they feel, will exonerate him, and protect him against any future prosecution.

the condition of the eggs, as few had spoiled. The good eggs could be distinguished at a glance from the rotten red color, and the presence of the "eye," the tiny fish inside which often could be seen moving within the spheres.

**Hatch in 60 Days.**

These eggs were placed in iron baskets, 50,000 to a basket, let down into the long troughs through which spring water runs constantly. So 150 of the baskets were needed to hold the 7,500,000 embryonic salmon. The baskets will be moved in the water each day and the dead eggs removed. Hatching comes in water of the temperature at this plant, in from 50 to 54 days.

When the tiny fish leave the eggs they filter out between the bars of the baskets and into the troughs, from which they are drawn off with the water. The hatching period varies with the temperature of the water, and can be shortened by warmth, but the result is poor fish. So the practice is not to hurry.

# FISH HATCHERY IS NOW AT WORK

State Fish Commission Plant 5,000,000 Salmon Eggs in the Ponds.

ENTERPRISE, Oct. 6.—The new fish hatchery became a reality on Tuesday when the state commission placed 7,500,000 sock-eye salmon eggs in the troughs in the uncompleted building, a mile southwest of town. R. E. Clinton, state superintendent of hatcheries, came to supervise the opening of the plant, of which his son, D. A. Clinton, is in charge.

The eggs are from the United States Bureau of Fisheries and were taken at a government establishment at Kodiak, Alaska. They came by boat to Seattle and were 12 days on the ocean. They were in 17 shipping boxes, in which the eggs were spread out in trays, with ice in the bottom of each chest and moss spread over the top trays.
