been turned through a canal into Klamath River, and Lake Lake has been slowly but surely drying up. The lands to be opened comprise the area surrounded by this process. The farm units included in the opening are an irrigable area varying from 12 to 80 acres each. The lands are comparatively smooth, free from brush, trees and stones, and the soil is of sedimentary character composed of sand and silt.

The elevation is about 4,000 feet above sea level. The temperature varies from 15 degrees below to 100 degrees above zero. The winters are long and the growing season rather short. The principal crops are hay and grain, and potatoes have been grown successfully on the lake lands; also good crops of the harder vegetables. The amount of danger from frosts is usually not adapted to fruit growing. In fact this is essentially a livestock country.

Most of the land can be put in good condition for irrigation for about \$10 per acre. It is likely to cost from \$25 to \$30 an acre more to secure a good stand of alfalfa. The nearest railroad is at Klamath Falls, 20 miles from the land but the state highway runs from Klamath Falls to Malheur. The cost of water right is \$50 per acre, but the terms of payment are very easy. At the time of making water-right application a deposit of 5 per cent of the cost of water right, or \$4.50 per irrigable acre is required. No

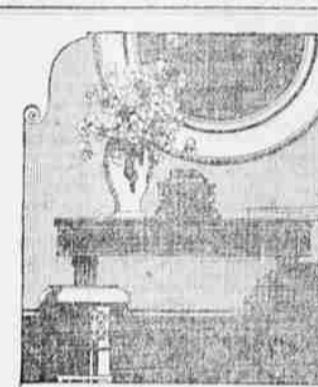
