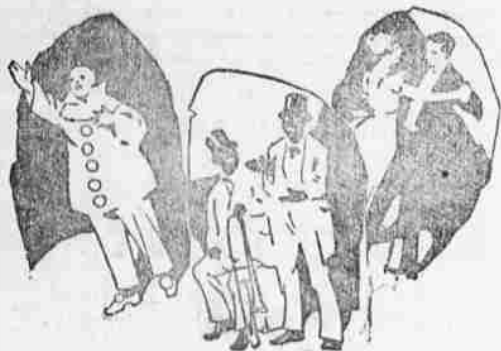

Noted Singer Will Appear in That City on the Evening of October 21st.
