

WORLD'S OLDEST STRIKER DIES

BURLINGTON, Ia., Oct. 18. (Special).—Funeral services for Albert M. Parmeter, oldest striker in the world, having been on strike from 1888 until the time of his death, were held Wednesday from his home here, and 400 striking shopmen on the Burlington route marched in the funeral procession.

Mr. Parmeter was 87 years old, and operated a wood-burning engine on the Burlington long before a bridge was built across the Mississippi river. He went out on strike with the Brotherhood of Locomotive Engineers on the Burlington in 1888, and never returned to work as the strike was never settled.

From that date until the time of his death he drew strike pay, amounting to thousands of dollars, from the brotherhood.
