GENERAL WOOD BACKS SPORTS

General Leonard Wood Likes Athletics in General and Especially Wrestling and Boxing.

MANILA, P. I., Oct. 2. (By Mail).—Expressing his approval of athletic sports in general and wrestling and boxing in particular, General Leonard Wood has announced he hoped every city and town in the Philippine Islands would be content in search of a strong team to compete in the Far Eastern games at Osaka, Japan, next May. "I believe in clean sport and athletic training," said Gen. Wood. "Sound athletic training makes better men physically, cultivates the spirit of fair play and the idea of give and take. It increases a man's self-confidence, and builds up a physical condition in order to attain which there must be an observance of self-restraint, good habits and sound moral principles. All-round athletic training should be built up in the Philippines in every possible way, especially in the schools. I wish every boy in the islands knew how to box, and to wrestle, and to do both well. They would be better citizens. The tremendous increase in the morale, the self-confidence of a man that is engendered by boxing, wrestling and other hand to hand sport is of incalculable value in any crisis of his life.

"With reference to the Far Eastern games to be held in Osaka next year, we ought to search every city, every municipality and every barrio in the Philippines for good material. There is no reason why there should not be and there is every reason where there should be a trial in all the schools, beginning with the university and high schools to pick out boys who have special qualifications and who promise to make good material to be worked on and developed with a view to participation in the Far Eastern games.

POWER PLANTS SHOW GROWTH

TOKYO, Sept. 26. (By Mail).—Power produced by hydro-electric plants in Japan continues to show steady growth. The generating power recorded an increase of 40,000 kilowatts during the first half of last year over the corresponding period of the preceding year, and an increase of \$1,000 kilowatts during the first half of the current year over the corresponding period of the preceding year. This growth of generating power is chiefly due to the development of hydro-electric enterprises. The official returns recently published put the increase of the capital last year at \$4,000,000, and this year at \$44,000,000 yen. The number of companies, however, records quite a limited growth. This fact is due to the amalgamation of minor concerns. The Tokyo Electric Light company has registered an increase of its capital in consequence of amalgamation by something like \$2,000,000 yen during the first half of the current year.

WILL LECTURE IN AMERICA

DETROIT, Oct. 2. (By Mail).—Among three prominent German sci-

entists who have accepted invitations to lecture before American universities the coming winter is Professor Heinrich Pich, director of the Gotha collection of coins. The Gotha exhibit was established in 1712 and includes 100,000 pieces. Its Greek and Roman specimens being especially noteworthy.

SWEDE STARS TO AMERICA

Swedish Theatrical Stars are Coming to United States to Seek Laurels.

STOCKHOLM, Oct. 2. (By Mail).—As a result of the purpose to bring about closer relations between Sweden and the United States, Swedish leaders in the theatre, opera, science and athletics are about to leave their shores for America, there to appear each in his or her particular field. Thus nineteen-year-old Arne Borg who has broken the world's swimming record for 40 yards, 460 and 550 meters, will go to the United States in February to match his speed with Weismuller in a series of races under the auspices of the Illinois Athletic club. Another athlete who deserves to be watched is Christiernsson, Sweden's best hurdler, who also is going to America. Among the men of science who have already left is Dr. Robert Barany, of Upsala University, who has made important contribution to the knowledge of the labyrinth of the ear as the organ of equilibrium. Dr. Barany will lecture at American universities and before various scientific associations. Another medical expert who will lecture in America is Dr. Einar Key, a specialist in surgery. Dr. Sven Hedin, discoverer of Transhimalaya, also will lecture in America this winter before starting on a new expedition into Tibet. A theatrical star who has just returned from America is Anders

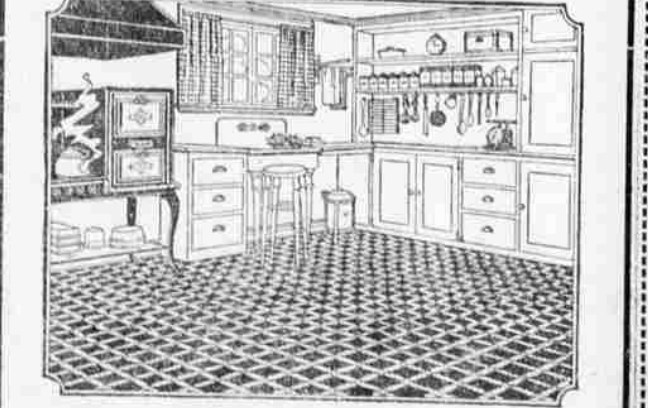
