

ANOTHER STEP TO AID VETS

Maximum Allowance Made for World's War Veterans on Land Projects, Says Seattle Advice.

Disabled war veterans of this vicinity and the Pacific Northwest taking agricultural training under the direction of the government on their own or leased land projects will hereafter be entitled to a maximum of \$350 from the government for farm equipment, according to information given out by L. C. Joseph of Seattle, northwest district manager of the United States Veterans' Bureau. It is believed that this provision will stimulate training along agricultural lines on the part of veterans in line for rehabilitation under the direction of the Veterans' Bureau, he stated. Loan money will be needed by the veteran to establish himself on a farm.

There are 234 disabled war veterans in the Pacific Northwest training to become capable farmers on their own or leased land at the present time, Mr. Joseph said. These men receive \$30 a month or more from the government until they are able to handle their land projects without outside aid. A total of approximately 500 other vocational trainees of this district are learning agricultural work of various kinds.

Veterans' organizations everywhere are pushing the congressional measure known as the Rusk bill which will, if passed, administer loans on farm mortgage security to disabled war veterans not to exceed 75 per cent of the total value of the farm real estate nor \$2000 to a man. Not more than \$1000 shall be advanced at one time.

HUSKIES PLAN TO BE CHAMPS

SEATTLE, Wash., Nov. 8.—Three varsity boats and 100 freshmen are working out on Lake Washington here to keep for the University of Washington the intercollegiate rowing championship of the Pacific coast.

CONSTANTINOPLE, Nov. 8.—Turkish Nationalists report that British have evacuated Mosul on the Tigris in Mesopotamia, and Kemalists have entered. Three additional classes of Turkish soldiers have been called to the colors.

All Kemal Bey, editor of an anti-nationalist newspaper has been arrested and condemned to death by the Turkish authorities here. The Allied representatives have given Hafez Pasha, the new civil governor of the city, forty-eight hours to release the editor.

ford University this year for the first time in a decade. The games were restored to the Stanford athletic schedule by Dr. W. H. Barrow, head of the department of physical

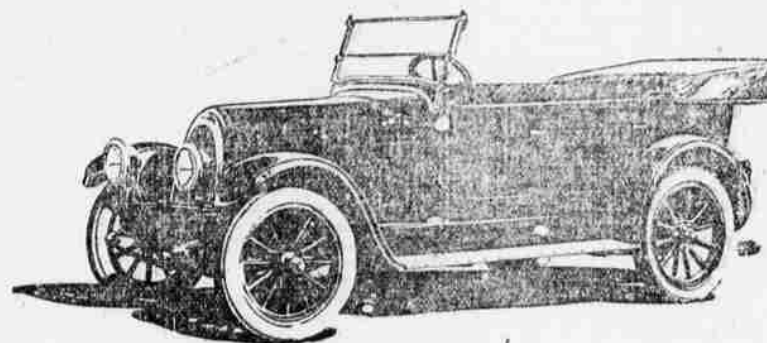
education, and by Coach Andrew Kerr. Participation of as many men as possible is desired so that material for the varsity squad may be found.

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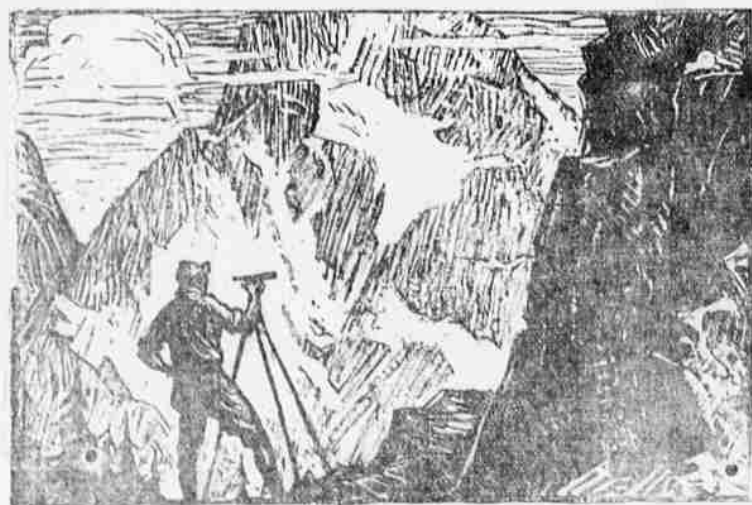
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
