

HAS POWER TO HANDLE C. P.

Interstate Commerce Commission Can Do as It Likes With Railroads.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 10.—Inquiry here develops the fact that in interstate commerce commission circles no doubt is entertained as to the power of the commission to authorize the control of the Central Pacific by the Southern Pacific by lease or by stock ownership.

Nor does it appear that any doubt is held as to the authority of the commission to enter an order for consolidation of the two systems under the transportation act of 1920, although a letter written by Chairman McChord to the Medford Chamber of Commerce may seem to bear an opposite construction. It can be said with confidence that the commission will hear the matter when it is brought up, and it is not considered that the supreme court took cognizance in any way of the transportation act, which was passed long after the issues in the merger case were made up.

It may be observed that the pending application of the Southern Pacific company to control the Central has no relation to the consolidation proceedings, and it is upon this petition that the struggle over the Central will no doubt first come before the commission. The Southern's petition is brought under the following provision of the law of 1920:

"Whenever the commission is in opinion, after hearing, upon application of any carrier or carriers engaged in the transportation of passengers or property subject to this act, that the acquisition to the extent indicated by the commission, by one of such carriers of the control of any such carrier or carriers either under a lease or by the purchase of stock or in any other manner not involving consolidation of such carriers into a single system for ownership and operation, will be in the public interest, the commission shall have authority by order to approve and authorize such acquisition; under such rules and regulations and for such consideration and on such terms and conditions as shall be found by the commission to be just and reasonable in the premises."

The petition of the Southern Pacific asks for control on both grounds specified, by lease and by stock ownership. The question for the commission will be as to whether this is "in the public interest." This question can be brought before the commission without any great delay.
