shall for the purpose of determining the amount of income under the revenue act of 1921, keep such pertinent books of account or records, including inventories, as are necessary to establish the amount of gross income and deductions, credits and other information required by an income tax return.

By keeping the required books of account which shall be produced for the inspection of revenue officers authorized by law to inspect the same, Collector Huntley says taxpayers will greatly simplify the task of making out their income tax returns for the current year. All such returns must be filed in his office not later than March 15, 1923.
