Railroad officials have been profuse in promises to relieve the car shortage, but so far little relief has been noted, though in the South shippers are getting a slightly larger percentage of their car requirements than they were several weeks ago. Thus shipments of both eastern hardwoods and southern pine are being increased slightly. Experienced observers who have recently traveled among the mills in all sections of the country report that they can hardly recall the time when stocks have been so badly broken and so ill-assorted as at present. No excess of lumber is being carried anywhere, and the lumber industry is approaching winter, which restricts output in a large part of the producing area.

Another factor which is likely to curtail production is the increased overhauling of machinery and stoppages of operation to install new equipment. On the Pacific coast this improvement in the machinery has been noted and manufacturers hardly expect any change in the situation until after the first of the year. In the meantime, construction remains brisk for this season and the volume of new building indicated by estimates for 1934 and their to exceed even the record of 1932.
