Experts Will Meet in Portland on December 19 for Annual Meeting of the Oregon State Drainage Association.

PORTLAND, Nov. 23.—Drainage experts will gather in Portland on Tuesday, December 19, for the annual meeting of the Oregon State Drainage Association. Announcement of the meeting has been made by W. L. Powers, professor of soils at the Oregon Agricultural college at Corvallis and secretary of the association.

DISCOVERS RADIUM ORE

The national observance of "Cancer Week," when public-spirited men, most of them physicians, have shown their sympathy for the victims of cancer, has again turned attention to radium as one of the principal agencies for curing this appalling scourge. Radium is not a specific for cancer, the whole truth is, it is specific, but it has repeatedly proved to be of very great aid in the treatment not only of cancer but of some other diseases.

Almost simultaneously with "Cancer Week," according to the United States Geological Survey, Department of the Interior, there has been a great drop in the price of radium. Instead of the former price of \$12,000 per gram (about 15.4 grains) of elemental radium, the price now advertised is \$20,000 per gram.

A considerable reduction in price had preceded this drop, because several manufacturers had on hand considerable stocks of radium which, owing to the present financial conditions, were not sold readily. The recent great drop, however, was not due to this cause—it was due to the discovery in Katanga, in Belgian Congo, of large deposits of very rich, easily worked radium ore and to the erection of a plant at Jadot, Belgium, about 40 miles from Antwerp, for producing radium from these ores.

Idaho Fresh Chances.

MOSCOW, Ida., Nov. 21.—Even though the University of Idaho vacated its football team may finish well down on the Pacific Coast Conference list, the Idaho first year team has a legitimate claim to the conference championship of four states, Washington, Idaho, Washington and Oregon. LOS ANGELES, Nov. 23.—Jimmy Murphy, California automobile race pilot, is so far ahead in the race for this year's national speed crown that he cannot be overtaken, even if defeated in the last big contest of the year, the Thanksgiving Day race on the Beverly Hills speedway near here.

According to A. M. Young, secretary and manager of the Los Angeles Speedway Association, Murphy has 2,820 points already. Tommy Milton, 1921 champion, is in second place

with 1,150 points and cannot take the lead, even if Murphy should not place at all Thanksgiving Day.

SLIDE VIEWS USED.
