QUIGLEY TALKS ON CLEMENCEAU

Clemenceau is giving Americans some unpalatable truths in his famous speeches now being made in America, and whether we like them or not they are the truth, declared Rev. Geo. H. Quigley at the Methodist church last evening in the first of a series of four Sunday evening meetings touching upon much-discussed topics of the day. "Am I my brother's keeper?" was the topic last evening, and in the address the speaker touched at some length upon world questions showing by concrete illustrations that Uncle Sam is his brother's keeper. Preliminary to his discourse, the speaker drew the setting by hastily reviewing the old Testament, noting that in some quarters readers of the Bible are putting new interpretations upon that part of the Bible, but that the essentials have not been changed or eliminated and that "Vitality is taking the place of historicity."

"Every man for himself and the Devil take the hindmost is a law of the jungle," said Rev. Quigley, adding that "The law of the Kingdom is to will take the hindmost." "The growth of civilization is measured by its conviction that we are our brother's keeper" was another concrete statement in proof of the affirmative position taken by the speaker on the subject.

Special music and congregational singing made up the evening's features. Worthy of special mention was the solo "Open the Gates of the Temple," (Knapp) sung by Mr. Paul Khamis.
