In the United States there are thirteen thousand girls, 15 years old, legally married.

Miss Linda Richards of Boston, now eighty years of age, was the first graduate nurse in America.

An industrial school with nearly 100 pupils is owned and supported by the Georgia Federation of Women's clubs.

Miss Ethel May Bradford is the director of the course in bee husbandry recently established by the University of Saskatchewan.

Rev. Orietta Stoddard, a 14-year-old girl of Miami, Okla., is a regularly licensed preacher of the Methodist Episcopal church.

Miss Alice Van Loan, who is more than one hundred years old, is an active member of the women voters' league of Green county, New York.

Mrs. Hideo Yamamoto, who has been appointed secretary to the Osaka Education Department, is the first woman in Japan to hold a municipal position.

Lady Bathurst has the distinction of being the only woman in England who owns a newspaper, the London Post, and takes an active part in its management.

Mrs. Sydney Small, the only woman alderman of Toronto, Ont., has been visiting New York, Washington and other cities to study problems of municipal government.

A movement to have women appointed to legal positions in the various departments of the federal government is being fostered by the Women's Bar Association of the District of Columbia.

An avenue of trees connecting the cities of Winston-Salem and High Point is to be planted by the Women's club of Winston-Salem as a memorial to the soldiers of Forsyth county, North Carolina, who served in the World war.

Girl welfare, women in industry, housing conditions, immigration, and international relations are among the subjects to be discussed by the National Council of Catholic Women at its second annual convention in Washington, D. C., November 21-25.

Miss Annie Jewett, business manager of a large Chicago cafeteria, is in charge of the campaign undertaken by the National Restaurant Association to direct the attention of trained and educated women to the restaurant business as a profitable and otherwise desirable profession.

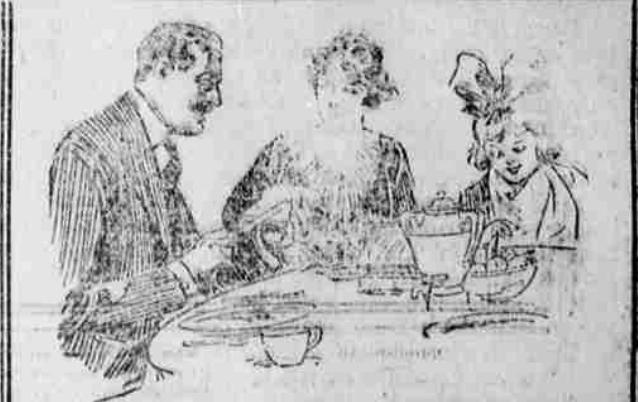
