On total yardage gained and lost in scrimmage, Wallowa gained 18 yards and lost 21. La Grande made 17 first downs from scrimmage to Wallowa's one.

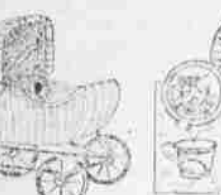
