LANTERN SLIDES POPULAR
EUGENE, Dec. 1.—Approximately 182,000 persons have been reached by the visual instruction service of the University of Oregon Extension Division thus far this year, according to a report made by Earl Kilpatrick, director. Two hundred communities in Oregon now use the slide service of the division, many of them regularly, while 61 communities make use of the film service.

"Rural schools and communities are making use of the slide service more, generally each year," said Director Kilpatrick, "and this is one of the most valuable of pedagogical helps that have been made available to the rural schools in recent years."

The slide library of the Extension Division has been gradually built up since 1916, so that only a few of the extension divisions of American universities have better of larger libraries. Classes in the Portland Center of the University of Oregon are more heavily attended than ever before, enrollment at present being 1490.

The Teachers' Reading Circle given under the direction of the Extension Service has proved very profitable. Four thousand eight-hundred Reading Circle papers have been read during the year 1921-1922. During the past ten months the University has arranged for the appearance of many speakers at community meetings and gatherings, teachers institutes and commencements. This service has reached more than 50,000 persons, according to Director Kilpatrick's report.
