OREGON MAY BE CHOSEN

University of Oregon Has a Good Chance to Represent West at Pasadena.

EGEGNE, Dec. 5.—The University of Oregon varsity football team which closed its scheduled football season Thanksgiving day by battling the University of Washington business to a 3 to 2 tie at Seattle stands a very good chance of being selected by the Pacific coast conference as the team to play Penn State at Pasadena in the big annual east-west contest, according to reports reaching the campus today from conference circles.

California and Washington, with whom Oregon is tied for first honors in the Pacific coast conference and Northwest conferences, respectively, have declined to consider a bid to play at Pasadena. This leaves the choice narrowed down to the University of Southern California and Oregon.

Oregon's chances loom brightly. The Webfooters have gone through the season undefeated, and have won three conference games, tied another, and lost none for a standing of 1000 whereas Southern California has lost one game and won three for a percentage of .750.

The Pacific coast conference will select the team within the next few days. Professor U. G. Dubach, of O. A. C., president of the conference, sent out letters to all conference members, sometime ago telling them to send in their votes immediately after the Thanksgiving day games. While it is expected these votes will be coming in within the next few days, and the decision announced shortly, it is possible the matter will not be settled until next week when the conference convenes in Seattle.

It is felt in some circles that U. S. C. will be favored because the Trojans held the California "wonder team" to a 12 to 0 victory while Oregon did not meet the Bruins. Graduate Manager Benefield made every effort to schedule a game with California this season but was unable to find an open date. It is also to be observed that Southern California played but few northern games, Idaho and W. S. C., both of whom are far down the list in conference standings.

Following are the conference records of both teams: University of Oregon: Oregon 3, Idaho 0; Oregon 19, Washington State 0; Oregon 10, Oregon Aggies 0; Oregon 3, Washington 2. Total, Oregon 29, Opponents 2.

Southern California: Southern California 0, California 12; Southern California 6, Stanford 0; Southern California 14, Idaho 0; Southern California 41, Washington State 3. Total, Southern California 61, Opponents 15.

Oregon's tie game with the University of Washington came as a fitting climax for a long hard season which has seen the Oregon coaching

staff encountering many difficulties in the way of injuries and constant set-backs. From the first the team has been of winning caliber however, and its development during the past month has been spectacular.

If Oregon is selected it will be the third time this honor has befallen an Oregon eleven. Coach Bezek's 1916 team defeated the University of Pennsylvania at Pasadena in 1917 and Coach Huntington's eleven defeated Harvard University in all but the figures of the score 7 to 6 in a contest played there three years ago. Oregon's selection this year would see the teams of Coach and pupil vie, as the Penn State team is coached by Coach Bezek, Oregon mentor, in the days when Coach Huntington was star quarterback of the webfooters.

NEW YORK COW WINS FAME

NEW YORK, Dec. 5.—Another New York Holstein-Friesian cow has won fame by her milk and butter production. She is Poplar Jewess De Kol, owned by Wheatfield Farms Association, Inc., at La Salle. 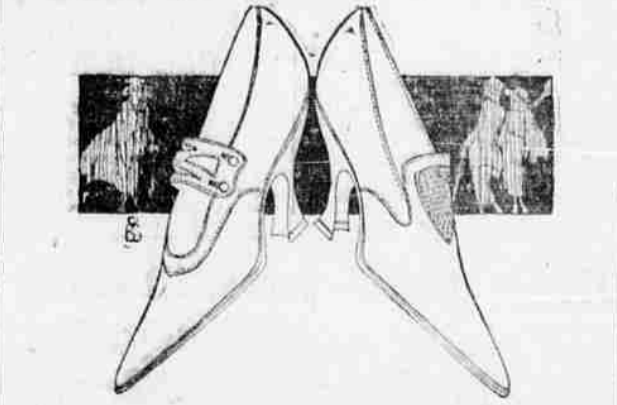
