Most of the lodges provide for sick members and funeral expenses funds for the members and each lodge is a complete unit in itself, with full local autonomy.

The local Moose are now having a dispensation and are building up their lodge. Initiation of a large class is to take place at their lodge commencing the Old Fellows building Thursday evening, December 7th, and all members

In addition to their lodge activities, Mooseheart, a modern home and vocational training school for more than 1,500 normal children of deceased members of the Order is maintained thirty-five miles west from Chicago on the Fox River.
