

INDIA LIKES TURK KEMAL

Mastapha Kemal is Popular
In India; to Present Him
With Three Airplanes and
a Sword.

DELHI, India, Nov. 2. (By Mail).—Three airplanes and a finely decorated sword are to be presented to Mastapha Kemal Pasha by Indian Mohammedans as tokens of their sympathy with his cause. These gifts have been offered through the Central Khilafat committee, which recently has been in session here. One of the airplanes is to be given by the Agra province.

The Khilafat committee, in the resolutions it passed, congratulated Mastapha Kemal Pasha and the Nationalist Turks upon their recent victories over the Greeks, and approved of the establishment of an Angora Legion in India. The government of France and Italy were thanked for the aid which they had given to Turkey. Appreciation was also expressed to the King of Afghanistan for granting equal rights to Hindus, in the interest of Hindu-Muslim unity.

With regard to the anti-Turkish policy recently displayed by Great Britain, the Khilafat committee was outspoken in its condemnation. Resolutions passed on this subject were as follows:

"This meeting of the Central Khilafat committee accepts the challenge thrown by Mr. Lloyd George, the British premier, in his speech at Manchester, to Asia on the one hand and Islam on the other, and assures him and other persons of his way of thinking that so far as Islam is con-

cerned, the challenge to the Moslems of the world, alive to their responsibility, are ever ready to meet in every possible manner.

"This meeting of the Central Khilafat committee considers the British activities in their attempts to internationalize the Turkish Straits, as unjust and coercive, and in the opinion of this committee such internationalization could only be justifiable in case the powers, especially Britain, internationalize the seas under their respective influence, and, further, in the opinion of this meeting, such attempts are detrimental to the freedom of the Khalifa of Islam and the seat of the Khalifat."

FOREIGN TRADE MAKES GAINS

Report of Bureau of Commerce Shows American Exporter Seizing Opportunities; Domestic Outlook Satisfactory.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 19.—American business has just gone through "one of the most crucial periods in the history of the nation's foreign

trade and has gained some ground against the inroads of a recovery against European competition." Dr. Julius Klein, director of the bureau of foreign and domestic commerce, declared in the annual report of the bureau made public Sunday. The American exporter, he said, has firmly there are markets.

grasped the opportunities presented and is entrenched in the world markets in a better fashion than ever before.

Doctor Klein's remarks concerning the broadening scope of this country's foreign trade were based primarily on a gradually increasing volume of exports together with a remarkable nation-wide interest in foreign trade as reflected by a 400 per cent increase in the number of inquiries received by the department of commerce on world markets in all lines.

The number of requests for foreign trade information are coming at the rate of 4000 a day now as compared with 1000 a day a year ago.

The great interest shown by American business men in foreign trade must not be allowed to wane, Doctor Klein declared, adding that every business man, either large or small, must be supplied with all data which would enable him better to meet new and changed conditions wherever

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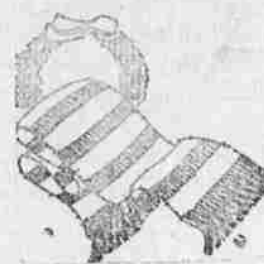
