A minuet danced by the little Misses Wilma and Helen Reed, Masters Rhonda and Chappell was given hearty applause. The talks of the program brought out the fact that the high school has been working for more than ten years to obtain money for the purchase of a suitable gymnasium. Now they should have the help and cooperation of the entire town to furnish and maintain a suitable building for the purpose of encouraging the many sports. Miss Allen, of the faculty, told of the girls' volleyball team, she has organized and also explained that the girls were as much in need of well directed exercise as the boys in the high

school. Mrs. Denham responded for the school board and Lee Tuttle spoke as one from the town. Adam Woods made the opening address, in Prof. Bailey's place and Mr. Cyrus, of the faculty, and as coach of the ball teams, gave his views of the matter. Although there is much work yet to be done, the building is in condition for use immediately by the basketball teams.
