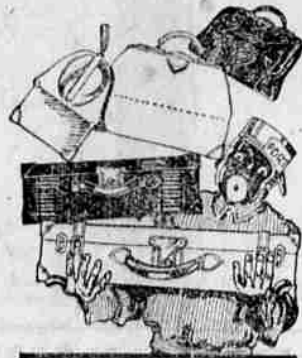

DAM SITE TESTS SATISFACTORY

The Thief Valley Reservoir Dam site is Progressing Satisfactorily, Although Slowly.

BAKER, Dec. 22. — Satisfactory progress is being made, though the work is slow, at the Thief Valley reservoir dam site, according to C. C. Fisher, engineer for the reclamation service, in a statement made at the weekly luncheon of the chamber of commerce today. A solid foundation has been found for the dam at a depth of nine feet below the river bed. The indications are that the site will prove satisfactory to the reclamation service, states the Baker Herald.

Secretary Mencham also read a wire from Representative N. J. Sinnott stating the sub-committee of the appropriations committee had approved the appropriation of \$500,000 for the Baker irrigation project. This is the amount recommended in the federal budget for the project. A letter from Ezra Meeker, who is in New York, stated that he had completed arrangements for the preliminary work for a scenario for the Old Oregon Trail, and hoped that this would result in the filming of a great historic picture of the great highway to the Oregon country.

Archie Service presented to the chamber a request for its endorsement of the erection of a large gas tank near the railroad. The request was made by Mr. Service on behalf of the Puritan Oil company which is seeking permission from the city to erect a storage tank and plant for distributing gasoline and oil on the west end of H street near the O. W. R. & N. tracks.

JOHN H. RUDD IS PROMOTED

Former La Grande Y. M. C. A. Man to Assume Responsible Position in Iowa

John H. Rudd, county work secretary of the Y. M. C. A., with headquarters in Portland, will leave the first of the year to assume a responsible position in that branch of the Y. M. C. A. work in Iowa.

Rudd has been with the local organization since 1915, being transferred from the La Grande branch, where he was general secretary. Previous to that he was dean of the county work school at Seabeck, Wash. It was largely through his influence that the construction of the present new Y. M. C. A. building in La Grande was carried through. From the office of boys' secretary in 1915, he rose to the position in 1918 of secretary of the county work of the interstate committee of Oregon and Idaho, which works with Portland as a center. His transfer to the same county work position in Iowa will bring him into contact with a larger and busier field and give him considerable scope for his special knowledge in that branch of Y. M. C. A. work. At the Wallowa grange election T. G. Johnson was re-elected master; Prof. E. T. Bailey lecturer and G. C. Meek secretary. They will hold their installation of officers on January 6, when an all day meeting will be held.
