TROUT EGGS SURVIVE COLD

Eastern Brook Trout Eggs to the Number of 203,000 Come Safely Through the Recent Cold Weather.

WALLOWA, Dec. 26.—Game Warden Rogers returned from Anseroid lake Thursday where he had been with a party of men from the Union trout hatchery to look after the spawning operations which have been conducted there this fall. A total of 203,000 Eastern Brook trout eggs had been secured there this fall and a young man by the name of Green and his wife had been stalled at the lake to look after the eggs and guard them against freezing until they have reached the "eyed" stage when it would be safe to take them to the hatchery to complete the hatching process.

During the blizzard and zero weather prevailing a few days ago this young man and his wife decided they had seen enough of Anseroid lake and pulled out, leaving the trout eggs to look out for themselves. Fish and game officials were fearful that the zero weather had ruined the eggs, which would have meant a large financial loss as well, several men having been at work up there all fall, but the game warden and his party found the eggs were still safe. Two men were left up there to look after the eggs for the next thirty days when they will have reached the stage in hatching so that it will be safe to move them.

MINAM RIVER LOGGING BIG

WALLOWA, Dec. 26.—Logging operations on the Minam river are being carried on actively this winter. The company plans to cut about seven million feet of logs, and will float them down to the mill at Minam next spring. In order to take care of the additional logs, several million feet being already in the pond, the dam is being raised seven feet. The work on the dam started this week and will back the water a considerable distance. The logs are at present frozen in the ice but it is planned to start sawing at full capacity as soon as possible.
