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

SPOKANE MAN MUST GO TO SEE CHILDREN WITHOUT TRUSTY GUN

SPOKANE, Wash., Jan. 8.—Hector M. Hulme of this city may still go to see his children, but he may not carry his gun along when he makes the visit, according to a ruling by Judge H. M. Webster, in superior court here. The ruling was made in an action for divorce brought against Hulme by his wife, Marie Hulme.

During the hearing of the case it was revealed that Hulme had carried the weapon with him when he visited the children. Mrs. Hulme's attorney contended that at future visits Hulme should be required to leave it at home.

Hulme objected on the grounds that he was employed by the city in a park and that it was a part of his duty to carry the weapon. He added that he was virtually on duty all the time.

The court, however, ruled against him.
