### VALENTINO FACES REAL BULLS IN PICTURE

Paramount Star Risks Life in His First Star Vehicle, "Blood and Sand."

Real Spanish fighting bulls were transported from Spain to Hollywood via Mexico for the sensational bull-fighting scenes of "Blood and Sand," Rodolph Valentino's first Paramount star picture which will be shown at the Arcade Theatre Thursday for three days. They are said to have differed from the domestic variety as "Man-o-War" differs from the humble truck horse. Running wild from birth on lonely ranches, shipped in black boxes to confine their isolation from mankind, they entered the arena with only the elemental instincts of wild animals, to kill and destroy any one daring enough to face them.

And Mr. Valentino had to get out in front of these interesting creatures! Sensational to the limit in the great Ibanex story of the life and loves of a young bull-fighter, are those scenes in which Mr. Valentino does sword and cape play before pickled animals of Senor Miran, the Duke of Veragua and the Marquis of Sallillo, the three leading bull-breeders in Spain. He was trained for the dangerous business by Rafael Palomar, famous Spanish matador, and was well-versed in the graceful art.

"Blood and Sand," a Fred Niblo production, is a story of a bull-fighter. It abounds in those colorful elements every American admires. 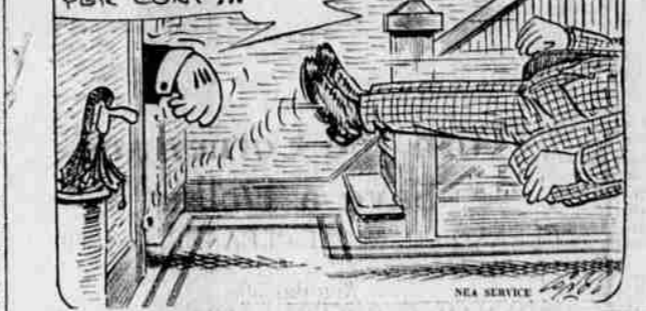

## COLLEGE GETS RARE VOLUME

EUGENE, Jan. 10.—A rare folio volume of the works of Abraham Cowley published in 1678 has been received by the University of Oregon library as a gift from C. Z. Zinsler of Heissou, Wn. Mr. Zinsler sent the gift "with kindest thoughts and best wishes to speed the campaign for a greater university."

The book, which was published in the reign of Queen Anne, shows on the fly-leaf many interesting scribbles in the hand of a former owner of the work, who left the following inscription in Latin: "Written in the first year of the reign of her majesty, Ann, Queen of Great Britain and Ireland by the grace of God, Anno Domini, June 14, 1709."

Another valuable addition to the University library collection is a gift of several volumes on history and science by F. H. Holbrook of Goble, Ore. The books include: "A history of Egypt," by Maspero and others in thirteen volumes published by the Grollier Society; "The Book of the Pearl," by Kunz and Stevenson; and "The War Between the States," by Alexander H. Stevens, in two volumes.

During the year just closed 241 dwellings costing \$485,330 were erected in Salem. This is 99 more than were built in 1921.

## Where thickness of a Hair Equals a Mile

THE hair of a human head averages from two to three thousandths of an inch, and if motor service shop work is based on accuracy so coarse as a "hair's breadth," only poor results can be obtained.

Automobiles may be designed alike, and look the same, yet, one, because of precise fits, has more power, speed and less vibration. When pistons and cylinder bores are held to limits of one thousandth plus or minus, it means that often a piston, 99.1 under size goes into a bore which is .001 over size; and, in place of a three-inch piston, instead of having a wall clearance of .002, .001 for each inch of piston diameter) it has .003 and becomes an "oil-pumper"—an error of less than an average hair's breadth, yet, the results could have been no worse had it been a "mile."

Avoid errors as broad as a hair and for closely fitted pistons, and perfectly ground cylinders have your repairmen bring your cylinder block to us for regrinding and piston assembling.
