NOTICE TO WOOD HAULERS. The following Rule for Measuring Pole Wood in Oregon is hereby promulgated by the Department of Weights and Measures and is now in effect. Rules for Measuring Pole Wood on Water—The distance between the standards of a Standard Wagon is 22 feet. The bottom and top load added together is 7 feet. Subtract 7 feet from the circumference of the load. The remainder is the sum of the sides of the load. (Length) Divide by 2 which will be one side. The equation will then be 22 feet X one side X the length of poles which gives the number of cubic feet in load. 1 foot and 7 inches around the load by 10 feet in length being the required measure per cord.
