SHERRY'S TODAY AND TOMORROW

New York in 1885 Shown in "The Old Homestead."

New York in 1885 visualized on the screen! Handsome cast, queer looking derby hats, cobble stone streets, gas lights at the street corners; a horse car drawn, however, by mules; Chinatown wedding queues; women wearing basques and small bustles and impossible hats; small boys with funny looking trousers or still warmer short ones; all the paraphernalia of Gotham in the days before automobiles, radio telephones, wireless, motion pictures, and other familiar things of today.

Persons who live in Manhattan today or those who have lived there will be carried back on the wings of memory when these street scenes for "The Old Homestead," a Paramount picture, are thrown on the screen James Cruze, the director, was careful that no anachronisms should slip through and it will be difficult to pick flaws in any sequence of the famous old play which is now to be seen in enlarged and elaborated form on the silver sheet.

T. Roy Barnes as Happy Jack, steals a pair of shoes in this sequence which shows a street around Third avenue in 1885. He hands the shoes to Reuben, played by Harrison Ford. Later Theodore Roberts as Uncle Josh comes along and offers Happy Jack a dollar before recognizing in him the tramp who escaped jail and took Reuben with him.

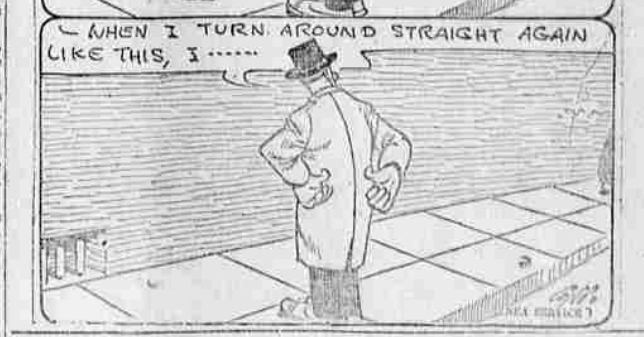

PINE BEETLES RAGE (By Associated Press) SAN FRANCISCO, Jan. 22.—One hundred million feet of timber in the Modoc National Forest of California has been killed by pine beetles during the last three years, according to the United States Forest Service here. In all, 430,000 acres of yellow pine timberland in this section, 145,000 of which is in private ownership, have been destroyed by the pest which for years has ravaged western forests.

Stringent control measures are now being undertaken by federal agencies of Southern Oregon and Northern California, as well as by private owners.

Where thickness of a Hair Equals a Mile

THE hair of a human head averages from two to three thousandths of an inch, and if motor service shop work is based on accuracy so coarse as a "hair's breadth," only poor results can be obtained. Automobiles may be designed alike, and look the same, yet one, because of precise fits, has more power, speed and less vibration. When pistons and cylinder bores are held to limits of one thousandth plus or minus, it means that after a piston .001 undersize goes into a bore which is .001 oversize and, in case of a three-inch piston, instead of having a wall clearance of .003 .001 for each inch of piston diameter) it has .005 and becomes an "oil-pumper"—an error of less than an average hair's breadth, yet, the results could have been no worse had it been a "mile." Avoid errors as broad as a hair and for closely fitted pistons and perfectly round cylinders have your repairman bring your cylinder block to us for regrounding and piston assembling.
