CLERKS WIN 100 TO TEN

Mark up Century Score Against the Ramblers; Imbler Defeats Alicel 48 to 22.

Clerks 100, Ramblers 10. Imbler 48, Alicel 22. With the Clerk and Imbler both winning last night's La Grande Amateur Basketball League's games, the standings of the team automatically shifted to some extent. The Clerk now lead with two won and none lost, the M. I. A. are second with one won and none lost, Imbler is in third place with one won and one lost, and Alicel, Union and the Ramblers are tied for cellar honors with one defeat each.

"100 to 10" Looks like the price of a dance ticket, one dollar and ten cents war tax, and it was in a way a sort of a dance ticket, at least it represents the way the Clerk danced to a score that reached the century mark while their opponents, the Ramblers, marked up ten points. This is the largest basketball score in the past few years, only one high score having been made in Eastern Oregon according to available record. That was when La Grande Grand let North Powder watch them ascend past the 100 mark, reaching a total of 104.

The Clerk were going in great form last night and the Ramblers, a strong team themselves, were completely outplayed in each and every department of the game. From present indications, the Clerk could, with a little practice be capable of giving any five on the Pacific coast a hard battle.

18 Points in 3 Minutes. The game started off with a rush and the Clerk promptly began registering in an automatic, sure way that found the score 23 to 4 at the end of the first quarter. At the end of the half the tally board said 47 to 5. In the third quarter the Clerk showed up somewhat, but at the same time kept their opponents scoreless, the score reaching 59 at this point of the game.

In the last quarter, the Clerk opened up with their heavy artillery and hit a pace that was faster than anything that has been seen in this section in years. In ten minutes' time they scored 41 points, 18 of those coming in the last three minutes of play! That's an average of 4 points per minute or a basket each 50 seconds.

"Foot" Garrity was high point man for the Clerk, with 19 field baskets and two fouls converted, and Larson was next with 15 field baskets. Keeney scored eight of the Ramblers' 10 points.

Imbler Beats Alicel. The Imbler team, who won from Alicel in the first game of the evening's double-header, proved too much for their opponents and at the end of the first half led 13 to 2. In the last half the two teams spurted and while Alicel was scoring 15, Imbler marked up 30 more.

Andrews, with 22, and Walkerfield with 21 were high point men for Imbler, and Truckman led the Alicel men with 10 points. Next Wednesday Union plays Alicel and the Ramblers meet the M. I. A.
