OREGON TRAIL DRIVE BEGUN
The Oregon Trail association received another inning today when the Oregon Trail committee reported its suggested quotas for business houses in support of the joint effort of all towns from Ontario to Seaside to combine their funds in one gigantic advertising and propaganda campaign under the direction of a board of leading businessmen of this state. The amount assigned to La Grande is about \$500.00 and will consist of \$1.00 memberships in the association. Secretary Reynolds is now ready to receive these membership subscriptions. Oil filling stations, garages, hotels, restaurants and grocery stores were deemed to be the greatest direct beneficiaries of the tourist trade, and a general scale of \$1.00 to \$5.00 for these institutions was adopted. General merchandise institutions were given a suggested quota of \$5.00. Smaller stores, and institutions of so-called

CROOKS GET NO PENSIONS

NEW YORK, Feb. 6.—No crook is on the pension list of the American Bankers association or ever has been, it is declared by F. N. Shepherd, executive manager of the organization, in reply to recent widely circulated reports that a notorious swindler had been bought off from his depredations against banks by means of an annual allowance.
"There is absolutely no basis of fact for this report," Mr. Shepherd said. "The American Bankers association conducts a protective department to prevent and prosecute criminal activities against banks who are members of the association with the idea of safeguarding property and bringing just punishment to offenders. It is no part of the work of the association to pay off criminals directly or indirectly.
The rules of the department expressly provide that no case once committed by a member bank of the association can be taken out of its hands nor the offense contained or compromised. Much less would a blanket compromise with the criminal activities of any crook by means of money tribute be entered into by the association. The only pension list the association has is one for retired employees in recognition for long and meritorious services."
