Oregon State Health Board Gives Statistics On Colds

Did you ever hear the remark "Everybody seems to have a cold now?" Sure you have. And did you ever hear the reply "Yes, it is mighty good weather for colds."

Having heard such bits of conversation and most probably having indulged yourself, did you ever tax your mental processes by trying to fathom the mystery of the "weather" as a producer of colds? The "weather" being unable to defend itself, you may be safe in blaming the weather for man's indiscretions, but you are not entirely correct in so doing. When you blamed the weather you recognized the fact that there was a common factor involved in the causation of wide-spread colds. Probably the most obvious common factor attributable to the community as a whole is the sudden and lessened, whether by chance, so the weather gets the credit, whether it be warm, hot, foggy, cloudy or sunshine. As a matter of fact the weather may or may not be a contributing cause, but is never a direct active cause that produces colds.

Colds are of bacterial origin and they are readily contagious. They are contracted by direct contact with a person suffering from a catarrhal condition of the nose and throat. They are transmitted by coughing, sneezing, spitting, handshakes, by eating utensils, and by close association in a room or building, office, school or theater, train and street car, or any other place where the individuals use over and over again the same air. If the body surface becomes chilled the resistance is lessened and the individual is more likely to catch cold. The condition itself is so trifling that vigorous individuals usually do not let the disease interfere with their daily pursuits, and in consequence promiscuous association continues without precautions. As a result colds usually go through families, schools, business groups, and rapidly become scattered in small epidemics throughout the community. While the cold itself may not be a serious factor it predisposes the possessor to more serious conditions, such as laryngitis, pharyngitis, bronchitis, influenza and the pneumonia.

All rooms and places, both public and private, should be so ventilated that the air in the room will be constantly changed. Individuals with colds should be temporarily segregated. Sneezing and coughing should never be done except when the mouth is covered with a handkerchief. All eating utensils should be sterilized after use; this should be mandatory for public places.

People with colds should not kiss their relatives; should refrain from handshaking; should sterilize or burn their handkerchiefs; should avoid exposing others by refraining from going to places of public amusement, riding in crowded vehicles, etc., until the cold has subsided.

If you have a cold the safest thing for yourself and for the community is for you to go to bed and remain there for 24 to 48 hours; take a mild purgative.
