### UNION PIONEER LADY INJURED

UNION, Feb. 19. (Special)—Saturday morning while working in the kitchen of her home in North Union, Mrs. Bell Wright had the misfortune to fall and break the bone in her leg a few inches below the hip joint. She was hurried to Hot Lake and an X-ray taken which showed that the bone was broken and very badly splintered. At latest reports it was not definitely known just what would be done for the injured limb, as Mrs. Wright, who had just celebrated her 73rd birthday anniversary, is almost too old to stand an operation which would be necessary in order to set the bone, and it is also doubtful if she could endure being in a cast for several weeks. Mrs. Wright is the widow of the late Tom Wright, and is one of the pioneers of this place.

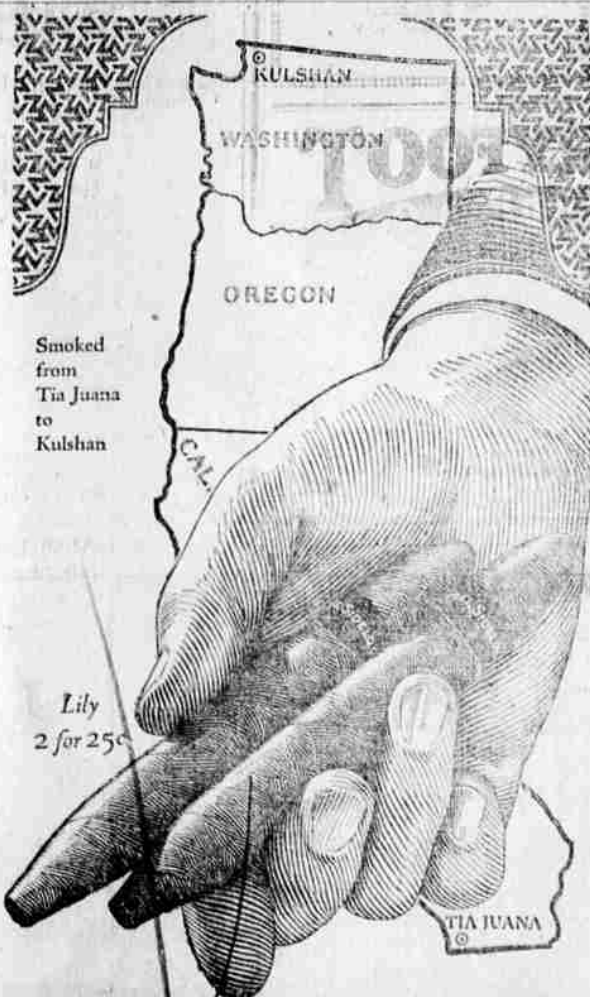

EUGENE, Or., Feb. 19.—An educational program, including addresses on methods of increased business efficiency is a feature of the program for the nineteenth annual convention of the Oregon State Retail Merchants' Association, which opens here today for a three-day session.

Following the opening program this morning the educational talks are to be given in the afternoon. Prof. F. A. Nagley is to talk on making advertising pay, Prof. C. L. Kelly,

on the proper creation of business costs, and Prof. F. E. Fells on the relations of businessman and banker. Further discussion along the same line is on the program for Tuesday. For Wednesday Prof. Nagley will talk on selling secrets that build business, Prof. Kelly on a bureau for compiling average costs, and Prof. Fells will again talk on a banking subject. The convention will close after election of officers and a banquet Wednesday evening.
