WHITMAN WOODS REPORT IS GIVEN

Nearly Fifteen Miles of New Road Built and 49 Miles of Old Road Worked Over in Whitman Forest.

BAKER, Feb. 19.—Forest Examiner Ira E. Jones, who is in charge of road and trail building on the Whitman Forest, has completed his annual report of this work. Mr. Jones states that last season a total of \$2,518.99 was expended on roads in the forest of which amount \$7,026 was contributed by Grant and Baker counties and the Eastern Oregon Light & Power company and the remaining \$26,786.83 was furnished by the forest service. With this money 14.6 miles of new road was built, and 49 miles of old road was worked over, states the Baker Democrat.

On trails the forest service expended \$7,204.99, building 49.5 miles of new trail, as well as cleaning up and maintaining in condition 402 miles of previously constructed trail. A transportation system of roads and trails is gradually being built up by the service, which is of the greatest value in the protection and administration of the forest, as well as to the use of this public property by the people.

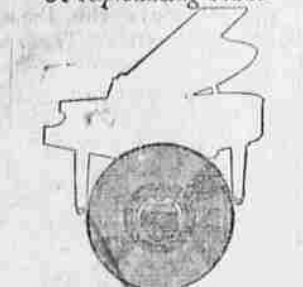
The North Powder high school was the scene of a pleasant social time on the evening of February 15th. The freshman class gave a party for the faculty and upper classes.

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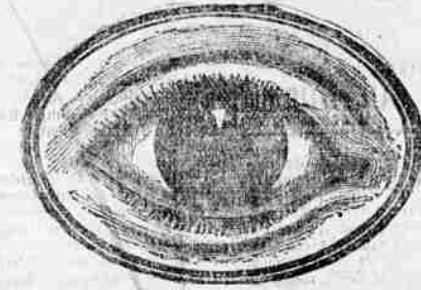
