GERMANS LOSE HOPES OF RUSS COMMERCE

BIBERT-LITVINSKI, Poland, Jan. 17. (By Mail).—March second will be the fifth anniversary of the treaty of Brest-Litovsk. Joffe and Litvinski and their Bolshevik associates permit their signatures "willingly" to the hateful paper after General Hoffmann had pocketed the treaty and announced the Germans would advance immediately upon Petrograd and Moscow if the Bolsheviks delayed longer. That treaty was superseded by the Treaty of Rapallo, which Germany and Russia signed so unhesitatingly during the Gobos conference last spring that the business relations which Germany hoped would result in an exchange of considerable amounts of German manufactured goods for Russian raw materials have been suspended. German businessmen cannot deal with the bolshevik trade commissions any more successfully apparently, than the businessmen of other nations which have not severed treaty relations with Lenin's government.

Germany has found the bolsheviks quite and unsatisfactory associates. The Brest-Litovsk treaty put Russia effectively out of the great war, and was a hard blow to Germany for the eastern front. It also gave impetus to the revolution in the German army and navy and was an important cause of the German revolution of 1918-19.

The signing of the Rapallo treaty was another important development. It was almost universal condemnation from the rest of the world, and probably delayed for a long period the recognition of Russia by solvent nations which might have led to the financial assistance so necessary for her recovery.

Since signing the Brest-Litovsk treaty the bolsheviks have entered into a host of other international treaties. It was the recognition of the largest crop of international conferences any other European power ever had in ten times as many years. The bolsheviks have expelled their enemies from most of the country's regime. They have made peace with Poland and their Baltic neighbors. They

BIG ADDITION TO COLLEGE

(By The Associated Press) CHICAGO, Feb. 22.—Plans for construction of what will be one of the largest and largest urban university campuses in the country, together with the outlines of the buildings surrounding this campus, were announced here today.

The campus, that of the downtown division of Northwestern University at Evanston, Ill., together with the grounds upon which the buildings are to be situated, comprises nine acres of ground. These were purchased by the university, off Lake Shore Drive at Chicago, and in downtown Chicago, one mile from the loop, according to the statements of Architect James Gamble Rogers of New York, and President Walter Dill Scott, of Northwestern, made at a tea given today at the Case Club by Mrs. George A. McKillop, in honor of the event.

The value of the property at completion will be approximately \$15,000,000, as the grounds, purchased three and a half years ago, cost \$7,500,000 and have since doubled in value and the buildings will cost in the neighborhood of \$7,500,000 and possibly more.

According to Mr. Rogers, the buildings contemplated will include a teaching hospital, the dental school and a school of commerce, together with dormitories, convalescent and gymnasium.

The plan shows the general arrangement of the property as a huge football center rising many stories in the air with a complete elevator service. The other two schools—Law and Commerce, would be in low three-story buildings without elevators.

These buildings, with dormitories, convalescent and gymnasium, would surround on three sides, the McKillop campus, the athletic field of which would be open on the east.

At the main or business entrance are two large auditoriums, one seating seven hundred persons and the other two thousand persons.

President Walter Dill Scott, of Northwestern, in addressing those present at the tea, said:

"The only advance that offers a hope of constituting an epoch in civilization is an advance that will improve the benefits already gained in culture in the human profession, in science; that will also bring all these to bear on a new conception and a new application of service in all our human relationships."

"Architects said it by were given a place on which to locate a futuristic campus in Evanston and the Alexander McKillop Memorial campus offer to the citizens of Chicago a place on which to erect an effective agency for attaining a new epoch in civilization."

AMERICAN FRUIT CHEAT. LONDON, Feb. 22.—South American fruit is being increasingly used in England. Whereas in 1919 only 180,000 boxes came to this country, the arrivals at Southampton last year totaled 1,125,000 boxes. These were distributed to London and the leading provincial towns. Supplies are coming in freely this year and it is possible to buy fresh African plums and peaches here at moderate prices.

SLEEPING ILLNESS FATAL. OREGON CITY, Ore., Feb. 22.—Miss Kathleen M. Long, eldest daughter of Mr. and Mrs. M. H. Long at Fifteenth and Van Buren streets, Oregon City, died today of the St. Vincent's hospital from sleeping sickness. This is the first case from this city that has proved fatal and the third to have developed here.

The death of her brother, Mike Long, two years younger, which occurred December 20, 1922, is believed by the parents to have resulted in Miss Long's fatal illness. During the entire time while in the Portland hospital she frequently

talked of the young man, and since his death had continually grieved for him. His death was due to the other cause.
