FLYING SQUAD TO COME HERE

The Flying Squadron, called "A University in Motion, A Convention on Wheels," will reach La Grande for a series of meetings beginning Saturday, March 17, and will continue three days in the interest of law enforcement, civic righteousness, social and industrial justice.

The high school auditorium has been secured for the meeting place and the services will be conducted there at 8:00 and 7:30 p. m. daily with the exception of Monday afternoon, when the hour will be 2:30, so as not to conflict with the school hours.

The Flying Squadron Foundation, under whose auspices these meetings will be held, is conducting a nationwide tour, hoping to create public sentiment in maintaining and backing up the Volstead law. La Grande will be the 50th city where these meetings will be conducted and Oregon is the 45th state to be covered. The speakers come from Boise, Idaho, here, and will go from here to Walla Walla. All the principal cities in Oregon will be visited by these speakers. It was announced today by L. S. Middleton, advance man for the organization, who was in La Grande, conferring with the local committee, composed of A. E. Pryle, chairman, Mrs. R. W. Leighton, and these are being assisted by

a number of local citizens.

Middleton stated there would be two speakers for the first afternoon and evening, one for the second and two for the third. Those coming for the first day will be Frank S. Brown, the noted tax expert and cartoonist, and Fred W. Corbett, L. L. D., who it is said is a logical thinker, true to the cause he advocates, and who has devoted many hours to the cause he represents.

James H. Woertendyke will be the speaker for Sunday afternoon and evening. He is known as a "man with a message." He will deal with the legal constitutional and enforcement problems of the 18th amendment.

Oliver W. Stewart, president of the Flying Squadron Foundation, editor of the National Inquirer, formerly member of the Illinois legislature, and who is associated with Excelsior Hotel of Indiana for many years in the prohibition work, will deliver two addresses on the last day. With Mr. Stewart will be Rev. Norman C. Brown, who will also deliver two addresses. Miss Brown served as chaplain in the Illinois senate in 1921. She began to preach before she was fifteen years of age. She completed her four years of high school work in three years. She worked her way through college by preaching.

WILL IMPROVE GAS STATION

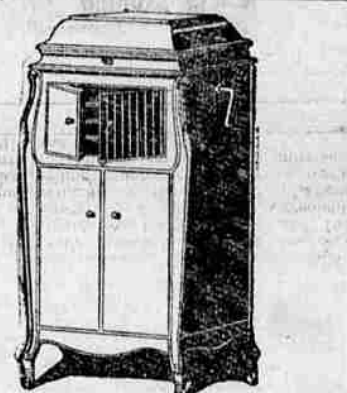
