impassable conditions of the Blue mountains. "I do not exaggerate," said Mr. Lewis, "when I tell you that the Blue mountains are labeled 'clear across this continent as the Jonah to automobilists. We took out a membership in the American Automobile Association and in every city we naturally went to headquarters of that concern for information. It was but natural for us to always ask about conditions of the roads in Oregon, and invariably we were told of the Blue mountain road between La Grande and Pendleton which prevented coast to coast travel and caused many automobilists to forsake a much coveted western trip."

Speaking of the roads in the different states, Mr. Lewis said he did not take off his hat to his native state in the comparison of highways. The roads that Oregon has built are better roads than he found in any state in the entire 14,000 mile trip. Next to Oregon came the state of Wyoming with its dirt road. He claims that the dirt roads in Wyoming are perfectly marvelous in the way they are graded and most of them are now being surfaced with a pink clay which makes ideal top dressing for automobile travel.
