IRON ORE DREAM MAY COME TRUE

GREAT FALLS, Mont., Mar. 31.—Possibility of the development into reality of the dream of the late Paris Gibson, formerly United States senator, friend of James J. Hill and founder of Great Falls, Montana, might become a producer of iron and steel, is seen by residents of Great Falls in the presence here of E. F. McCaughlin of Roanoke, Va., and P. H. Conner, representatives of a large Virginia iron company.

Iron ore in the Little Belt mountains was discovered in the latter '80's. Senator Gibson, with lieu land scrip given him for the purpose by James J. Hill, came out from St. Paul and took up the tract on which he laid out the city of Great Falls. The iron ore and the contiguity of coal deposits offered the possibility of a new Pittsburgh in the west, according to Senator Gibson.

When Senator Gibson died two years ago it was found that he had bought patents to several thousand acres of iron ore lands near Stanford, Mont. The deposit, which had been surveyed and described in a publication of the United States Geological Survey, runs fifty miles east and west in the Little Belt mountains.

Option on 600 acres near Neilhart has been secured by Mr. McCaughlin, and he is investigating freight rates on coke, pig iron and coal, and cost of electric power.

"FRYING PAN" CALLED BEYOND

TUCSON, Ariz., April 2.—The Grim Reaper has closed the eyes of one more member of the small and rapidly disappearing community of familiar and interesting characters of Tucson's daily life since the early colorful days of the Old Pueblo.

Charles ("Frying Pan") Alzamora, 70, a native of California, is dead here. Interment was made after an unavailing search for relatives.

During the early days, long before prohibition, Alzamora conducted lunch wagon in front of the old Congress Hall Saloon. He also served as "capper" at various gambling joints and often took a fling at the game of his own hook.

Old-timers tell the story of how acquired his nickname. It frequently happened, they say, that while in the midst of the preparation of an order for a hungry patron, Alzamora would get a "hunch." Immediately, all forgotten, he would make a dash for one of the tables, carrying his frying pan with him. Thus he became known as "Frying Pan." But this was abbreviated to "Pan" and later "Frying Pan," by which he was generally known at the time of his death.
